When Al Bonds: Realising the Promise, Avoiding the Perils in Social Research

A purpose designed experiment to test if conversational AI has unique benefits in a social research setting


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Approach

- N=3,800 online survey
- 3 data collection methods tested across 3 survey waves
- Complex social issue: Australians' attitudes to gender equality
- Participants segmented using Gender Compass framework


FINDING 1: Increased quantity of input

% uplift in words versus standard open ended




FINDING 3: Increased quality - emotional engagement

% displaying different emotions versus standard open ended (% points gap)




Overall conversational AI can:

- Elicit a greater volume of data for minimal investment
- Cover a more diverse range of related topics
- Stimulate greater emotional engagement
- Access more controversial or hidden views




FINDING 2: Increased quality - diversity of topics

% uplift in topics mentioned versus standard open ended



FINDING 4: Increased quality - candour & underlying views

Largest change (% point gap) in each sentiment category for each segment



Unique benefits of the two Al approaches tested:

- Tailored probes can support those with strong views to share less socially acceptable opinions
- New topic prompts can help draw out views of those who appear indifferent
